Distribution of Troublesome U.S. Agricultural Weeds Pilot Project

This effort seeks to generate awareness amongst growers, crop consultants, agronomists, and industry representatives of the distribution of common and troublesome weed species, and support the efforts of Extension Educators and weed scientists to track the spread of these weeds over time.

- **Barnyardgrass** (*Echinochloa crus-gallis*)
- **Common ragweed** (*Ambrosia artemisiifolia*)
- **Giant ragweed** (*Ambrosia trifida*)
- **Horseweed** (*Erigeron canadensis*)
- **Italian ryegrass** (*Lolium perenne* ssp. *multiflorum*)
- **Johnsongrass** (*Sorghum halepense*)
- **Kochia** (*Bassia scoparia*)
- **Palmer amaranth** (*Amaranthus palmeri*)
- **Waterhemp** (*Amaranthus tuberculatus*)

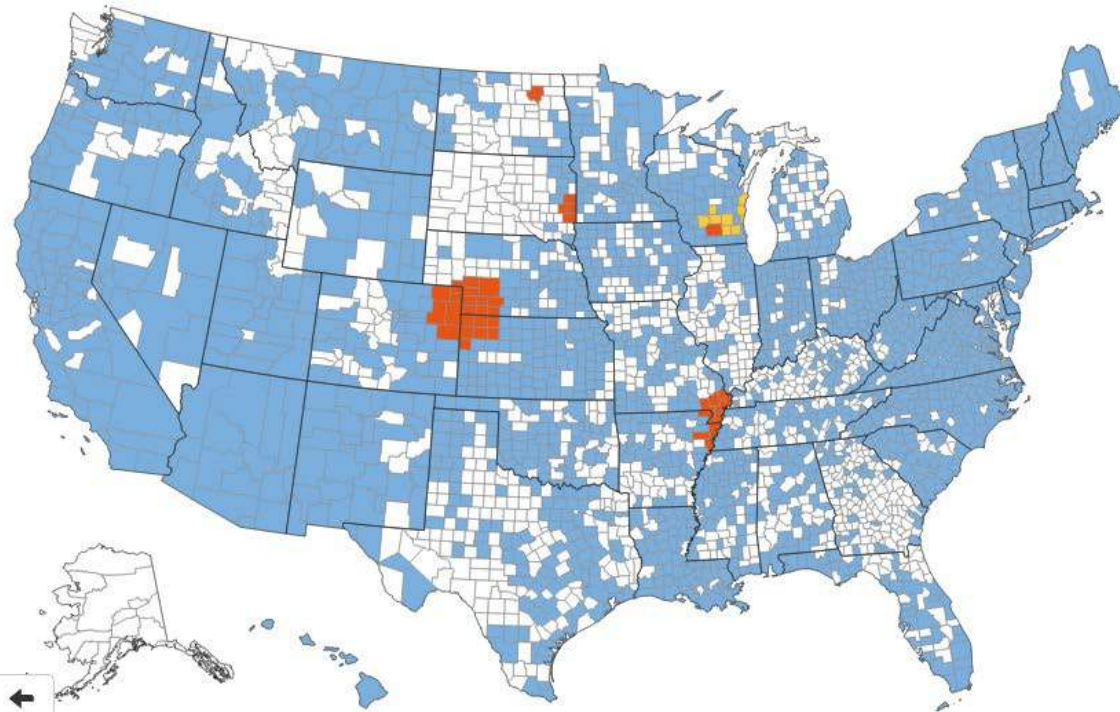

- Go to <https://www.eddmaps.org/report/commonweed/index.cfm?project=1475&projectAccessKey=NAICC>
- Sign in.
 - If you have an EDDMapS Account, you can use that
 - If you use a Google or Apple, it will create an account for you.
 - If you need to create an account - Click “Sign Up”, fill out the form to create an account, register, and sign in with credentials you just made.
- You should be on the map for reporting. Pan and zoom to where you are. After you do that, click “Select Counties” in the upper left of the map
- Just under “Select counties” are the colors for the Present, Common, and Troublesome Categories”
- Color in counties by their status. **You should only report for counties you have working knowledge in.**
 - Choose which category you're about to color in those counties.
 - Click and drag over the map to color those in or click counties one by one.
 - Pick your next color.
 - If you made a mistake, clear is always an option.
 - If you already had it pick one color and you click on it on a previously colored one, it's going to overwrite that color.
- After you get that done coloring, select the species. It will list for you the scientific name.
- Choose your commodity. If you start typing in the field, it will filter down from the available options.
- Set the report date. It's defaulting to today. You can pick whatever time period you were actually looking at.
- Comments are optional, but if you wish to wax poetic about why this is troublesome or what could be causing those issues, that may help researchers in the future.
- Hit submit and your report will be in.

To report additional weed species or the current weed species in a different commodity, click on the “back arrow” in your browser and repeat the process. This will not erase the report you previously submitted.
